ECHA MEMBER STATE COMMITTEE AGREED ON 3rd DRAFT DECISIONS RESULTING FROM DOSSIER EVALUATION AND ON THE IDENTIFICATION OF 8 SUBSTANCES OF VERY HIGH CONCERN

The Member State Committee also agreed unanimously on the identification of eight Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) that may become subject to authorisation.

These substances will be included in the 'Candidate List' after a decision on inclusion has been taken by ECHA. The 'Candidate List' will then be updated on ECHA's website in due course.

The agreement of the MSC concerns the following eight substances (CMR):
